Actualities

In January 2021, Aeromaritime Systembau GmbH, signed with the German Navy the contract for Technical Logistic Support TLB of the Digital Communications Network DCN for the four German F125 class frigates and the shore stations. The logistic support includes continuous services such as user help desk and obsolescence notifications, as well as on-demand services such as the preparation of analysis reports and the design of technical solutions. Furthermore, Aeromaritime is currently employed with orders for communication systems for the frigate F125 4th ship (Ship 1-3 finalized). Also the production of four further communication systems (ICS) for submarines of a NATO member, as well as IT system upgrades on various ship classes of the Norwegian Navy. Short-term orders for multi-function antennas for the newly appointed submarines further strengthened the market leadership in this product area.

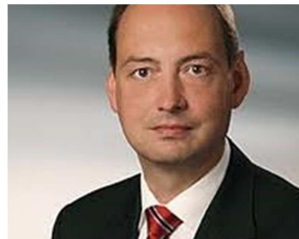
50th Anniversary
